# Intent to Register - Faculty of Arts and Humanities

If you are planning to return to Western in September 2015, you must submit an Intent to Register (ITR) form by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2015. If you do not, you will not have access to online registration for Fall/Winter 2015.
