



# International Exchange Program

## Quick Facts About the Program

**Academic Matters:** Students on exchange earn credit towards their Western degree, while paying Western tuition. Western guarantees credit for all *pre-approved* courses taken while on exchange.

**Who Can Apply:** It is recommended that students apply in their 2nd year to go on exchange during 3rd year. Eligibility is based on academic achievement in 1st and 2nd year, and the student's suitability as an ambassador for Western. An academic average of 70% is required, and suitability will be assessed through the application and an interview.



**Important Dates:** General information sessions will be held in October and November. The deadline to submit an application and supporting documentation is *January 2008* (details will be posted on our website). Interviews will be held in early February, and students are notified of their admission in early March.

**Destinations:** Australia, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Japan, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Singapore, Slovenia, Sweden, United Kingdom, and the United States. Some destinations are faculty specific and others are open to all faculties.



## Funding

There are many exchange scholarships available. \$50,000 in scholarships are being offered by Western to promote international exchanges. Please contact our office for details.
