

Guidelines for Accelerated Masters Research Project: GL9590/GP9590

Course Outline:

Students enrolled in the Accelerated Masters in Geology or Geophysics will work under the guidance of a Faculty Supervisor to complete an independent research project in Geology or Geophysics. The topic and scope of the research project will be agreed upon between the Student and the Faculty Supervisor; level of effort is expected to be commensurate with the equivalent of 4 months of full-time work. The project work will be documented in a written project report, and will be presented in a conference-style poster presentation session.

Grading & Deadlines:

Draft project report: introduction, literature review, and outline	10%	May 30, 2015
Complete first draft	For corrections from supervisor(s) only	August 4, 2015*
Final written project report	70%	August 14, 2015
Project presentation (poster)	20%	August 31, 2015

***Each student should discuss with his/her supervisor to set their own deadline to allow adequate time for editing and revision before submitting the final report.**

- The draft project introduction/outline will be marked by the Faculty Supervisor.
- The Final written project report will be marked by the Faculty Supervisor and one other Faculty reader.
- The Project presentations will be judged by all Faculty who attend the presentation session.
