2008-09 Ontario Graduate Scholarships in Science & <u>Technology (OGSST)</u>

Applications are invited for the 2008-09 Ontario Graduate Scholarships in Science & Technology (OGSST).

Value: Up to \$15,000, minimum two term award, maximum 3-term award.

Deadline for applications: 4 pm, March 21, 2008.

Eligibility: Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada, enrolled fulltime in graduate studies at the time of application. Applicants must have applied for all major scholarships for which they were eligible from May 1, 2007, and must have a minimum overall average of 80% (please see calculation details on poster outside B&G room 13). Applicants who are awarded another major external scholarship that will commence during the period May 1, 2008-April 30, 2009 will no longer be eligible for a 2008-2009 OGSST award.

Geophysics Graduate Travel Scholarship

Applications are invited for the Geophysics Graduate Travel Scholarship. There are up to 3 awards available annually, and one award remains open for the 2007-2008 year.

Eligibility: The applicant must be presenting a paper at a scientific conference. Any one student will be limited to one travel scholarship per M.Sc. program and two for the Ph.D. program; however, at the discretion of the Selection Committee, a student may be awarded one additional scholarship, provided that it does not deny an award to another qualified applicant who has received fewer Geophysics Travel Scholarships.

Value: Up to \$550

Deadline: February 29, 2007 to Dr. Kristy Tiampo.

Applicants are to apply via a letter to Dr. Tiampo, indicating the program they are in, stating

the meeting at which they are to present a paper, and provide proof of acceptance of that presentation, along with a copy of their student record.
