On October 25th, Education Minister Lisa Thompson announced that the government was introducing legislation requiring newly licensed teachers to complete a math test as a requisite for licensing through the Ontario College of Teachers.

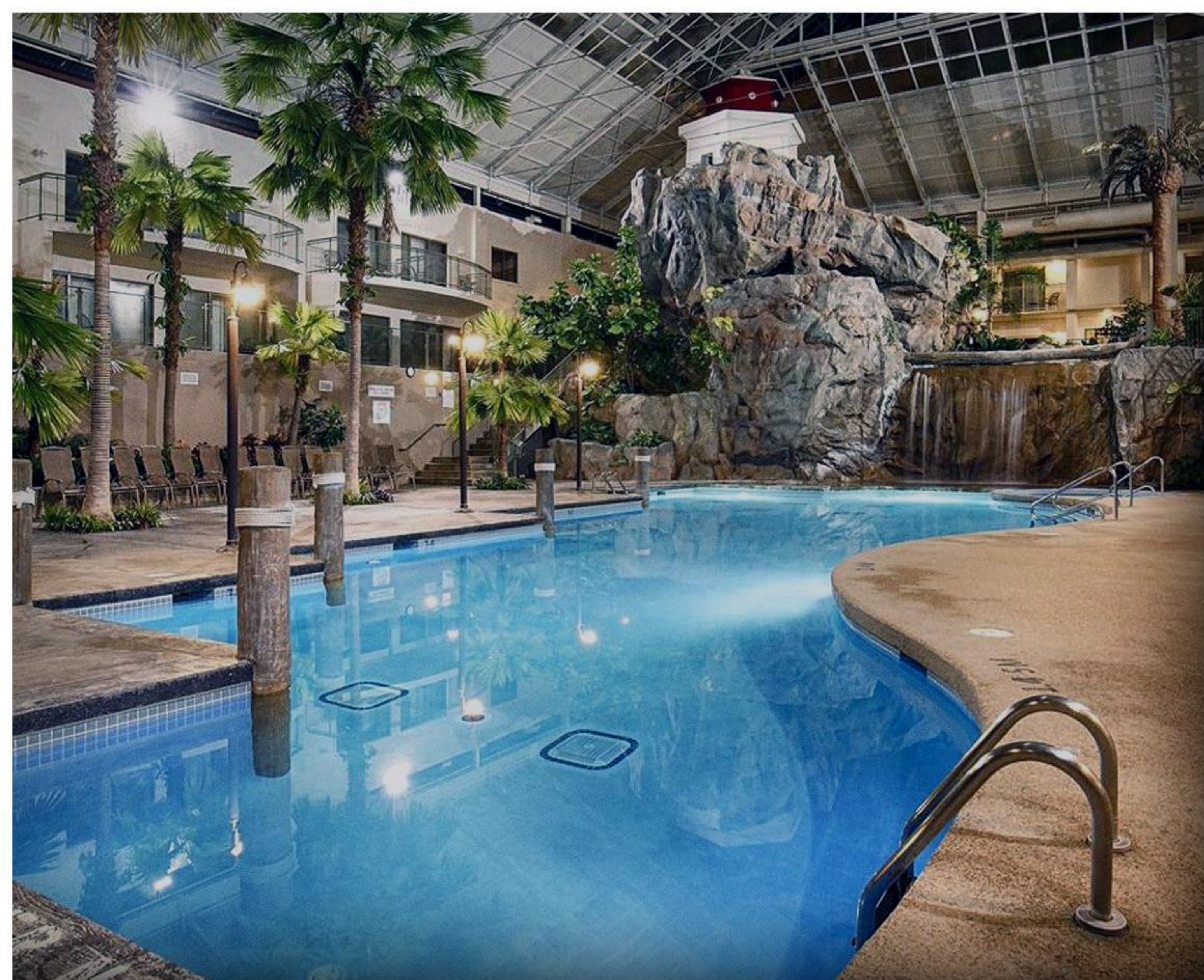
Annual Bubble Soccer Tournament
