This unique department combines management studies with a strong foundation in the social sciences. Applications are invited for a Limited-Term full-time appointment for a period of three years (renewable) at the rank of Lecturer in the area of Commercial Aviation Management. Candidates for this position must have relevant skills, qualifications and expertise, including relevant recent teaching experience. Completion of a graduate degree or appropriate professional qualification is expected, and a PhD would be considered advantageous. This is a full-time teaching position (research is not a

component of the workload in this position). Applicants must possess a record of excellence in teaching and be able to assume a program administration role. The successful candidate should demonstrate the ability to teach a broad cross-section of undergraduate courses in Commercial Aviation Management, will be expected to engage students in a variety of different classroom settings with varying class sizes, and will coordinate the delivery of the program as a whole. Contributing to ongoing curriculum and program development is also expected.

Salary will be commensurate with previous performance, qualifications and experience in accordance with the Collective Agreement. The preferred start date of appointment is 1 September 2023, but is negotiable.
