Major Snow Storm: Priority for Snow Removal Classification

During a typical snow fall, Facilities Management will have completed de-icing and snow removal prior to the start of each business day, with crews checking and maintaining campus throughout the day. The protocol changes with above average amounts of snow fall, particularly during the day. In the event of a major snow storm, Facilities Management will work hard to keep campus clear and safe, focussing on the following areas, which are considered priority due to factors of safety and traffic volume. The three snow removal units represent a group of vehicles and people that work on seperate locations consequetively.
