SEQUENCE OF TASK	POTENTIAL HAZARDS	ACTION OR PROCEDURE
1. Inspect power tool completely before plugging in to power source.	1. Changing blades & bits	1. Wear PPE
2. If changing bits or blades - make sure you unplug power tool		
3. Survey area that you are cutting or drilling into.		
4. Make sure power source (outlet or extension cord) is properly grounded and on safe surroundings.		
5. When power tool in no longer needed, unplug and move out of work area.		
6. When changing blades or bits - test power tool to insure proper installation		
Inspect tool/cord, to ensure safe	Projectile, burn, sharp material	PPE, anti - vibe gloves (I.R.)
Read operating instructions (If necessary)	struck by/against, vibration, R.S.I. position	Protect from damage, use G.F.C.I. (I.R.) If unsafe.
Replace attachments as required	Noise	TAG/ Ensure repair or replacement
