Assess and prepare equipment and materials	Electrocution	a) Check equipment for frayed wires     b) Test GFCI for electrically powered equipment
Follow procedure for screening hardwood floors	Overexertion, strain, injuries	a) A Manager or Lead Hand should be organizing the team when screening the big area, such as gymnasium or cafeteria. Staff members should be re-instructed if required.
If needed, contact manager to ensure cooling system is running until job is completed	Heat stress, heat exhaustion	<ul> <li>a) If you choose to damp mop the floor prior to screening (to maximize the amount of dust), ensure the appropriate types and sizes of the dry and wet mops/brooms are used.</li> <li>b) Use appropriate procedures and owners' manuals for all powered equipment.
