SEQUENCE OF TASK	POTENTIAL HAZARDS	ACTION OR PROCEDURE
Inspect tube cleaner for electrical GFCI compliance and safety operation	Electric shock	Refer to Electrical Awareness Training and follow manufacturer's instructions for safe operation of tube cleaner
Clean tubes	Repetitive strains	Take breaks to relieve stress in localized muscles. Ask for the assistance of a co-worker if needed. Keep work area clean. Improper position - ergonomics. Area will be wet and take extra precautions against slips and falls.
May require elevated platform while tube cleaning	Slip/trip/fall	Refer to Elevated Work Procedure/Training to eliminate hazard of working off the ground
