

Registered Associated Persons

Types and Definitions

Affiliated College – Faculty (ZZ003)

These individuals are faculty members employed by an Affiliated College (this includes Brescia, Huron, Kings and St. Peter's Seminary).

Affiliated College – Staff (ZZ004)

These individuals are staff employees of an Affiliated College (this includes Brescia, Huron, Kings and St. Peter's Seminary).

Affiliated College – Student Hire (ZZ005)

These individuals are students employed by an Affiliated College (this includes Brescia, Huron, Kings and St. Peter's Seminary). These students will have access to all Health and Safety training programs offered by the University.

Affiliated College - Professor Emeritus/a (ZAE00)

These individuals are retired faculty members designated as professor emeritus/a at an affiliated college (this includes Brescia, Huron, Kings and St. Peter's Seminary)

Affiliated Organization - Admin. Staff (ZZ520)

These individuals are employees of another organization which has some form of operating agreement in place with the University. The individual is in an Administrative position or in a role which supports a faculty, department or the other organization. Due to the strong teaching and/or research relationship that these organizations have with the University, these individuals require access to University resources due to the type of work they are performing or the nature of the collaboration. This includes research support staff requiring specific 'ROLA' access.

Affiliated Organization - Research Staff (ZZ521)

These individuals are employees of another organization which has some form of operating agreement in place with the University. The individual is in a research position in support of a faculty, department or the other organization. The position being filled by the individual is primarily focused on research activities; this includes research assistants, research associates, research technicians, research project coordinators, post docs and scientists. Scientists are typically individuals in senior research positions who normally supervise research activities. Due to the strong teaching and/or research relationship that these organizations have with the University, these individuals require access to University resources due to the type of work they are performing or the nature of the collaboration.

Board of Governors Member (ZZ651)

These individuals are elected as members of the Board of Governors of the University.

Chaplain (ZZ650)

These individuals are clergymen/clergywomen of various faith traditions or denominations appointed in the role of Chaplain to the University.

Clinical Educator (ZZ013)

These individuals are health care professionals who are in direct support of the University by supporting, assisting, mentoring and helping the University's students during their placements. These individuals are typically physically located in clinical settings at their own place of employment, such as hospitals. This includes clinical educators, clinical nurse specialists, nurse practitioners, dieticians, physical therapists, occupational therapists, audiologists, speech-language pathologists, etc..

Contracted Administrative Support (ZZ500)

These individuals are employees of an external agency/company with whom the University has contracted to perform administrative work for the University. These contracted services can include administrative/office support, financial or accounting support, software development, consulting services, etc.

Contracted Other (ZZ501)

These individuals are employees of an external agency/company with whom the University has contracted to perform work at the University in a non-administrative role. This may include individuals from the construction industry or a specialized trade.

Co-op Student (ZZ550)

These individuals are co-op students (including high school students) gaining work experience during an **unpaid** co-op placement at the University.

External Instructor (ZF002)

These individuals are not employees of the University, but are teaching a course in Kinesiology usually as a swimming or tennis instructor.

Fanshawe Instructor (ZZ014)

These individuals are Fanshawe College faculty members working at Fanshawe College in direct support of the Western-Fanshawe Collaborative BScN program.

Hospital Library Staff (ZZ008)

These individuals are library staff at other institutions (not at the University) providing regular assistance to the University's students, staff and faculty while they are performing research or other activities at those off-campus locations.

Student Council Member (ZZ660)

These individuals are elected Student Council members employed by The University Student Council for a 1 year term.

TUTOR-PHC Participant (ZZ020)

These individuals are participants in the TUTOR-PHC (Transdisciplinary Understanding and Training on Research – Primary Health Care) program currently associated with the Department of Family Medicine. The objective of this program is to build independent researchers through both opportunities for students and faculty (supervisor) development. It is a national research training program in primary health care to meet the immediate need for research capacity in this field.

Visiting Researcher/Scientist (ZZ601)

Visiting researchers/scientists are individuals who are on campus collaborating on research activities who do not hold a comparable academic appointment at another university/college. These individuals bring their expertise in their field to the University from industry, government, or a research institute/centre that is not affiliated with the University.

Visiting Scholar (ZZ600)

Visiting scholars are academics from another university/college that normally hold an academic appointment at that university/college that is comparable to the faculty appointments at the University. They are usually on temporary leave from their university/college. They visit the campus for relatively short periods of time, usually no longer than a year, to serve as senior researchers, collaborate on research projects and publications with faculty members, and pursue independent research. These individuals are not teaching courses at the University. Teaching of University courses requires an academic appointment.

Visiting Student (ZZ551)

A student from another university/college who is currently enrolled in a degree/diploma program at his/ her home institution, who wishes to visit the University to pursue independent research (usually in preparation of his/her doctoral dissertation), to enhance his/her own course of undergraduate or graduate study (including working on collaborative research), or to fulfill a requirement for the degree he/she is pursuing (this includes electives, rotations or external programs). These students are not formally registered at the University in a program or course.

Volunteer (ZZ700)

These individuals do not have an affiliation with the University, but have volunteered their time in support of University activities.
