

# ***Opportunities for Study and Work in Spain and Latin America***

## **I. What is Study Abroad?**

1. Students pay fees levied by host university overseas.
2. Students require a Letter of Permission from their Faculty, found at <http://www.registrar.uwo.ca/index.cfm/course-enrollment/letter-of-permission/>
3. You may choose which university you would like to attend. Some locations are suggested below.
4. Students receive numerical or alpha grades for no more than 5.0 credits.

## **II. What is an Exchange?**

1. Students will pay regular UWO Fees.
2. Students can apply for UWO Exchange Scholarships, found at [http://www.sdc.uwo.ca/int/exchange/index.html?outgoing\\_funding](http://www.sdc.uwo.ca/int/exchange/index.html?outgoing_funding)
  - Some scholarships include: The Ontario International Education Opportunity Scholarship, "Go Global" Arts and Humanities, Sunlight Foundation International Exchange Award, Diana Beattie Exchange Scholarship etc.
3. Students apply through the Exchange Office – apply early! Application deadlines vary. Check with Exchange Office.
4. Courses are marked as pass/fail or pass with distinction on the academic record.
5. Students may take no more than 5.0 credits.

## I. Study Abroad Destinations



### • **Universidad de Salamanca, Spain**

Four levels of Spanish are offered: beginners, intermediate, advanced, and superior. Many content-based courses are taught in Spanish (Spanish History, Culture, Literature and Visual Arts), and in English (Spanish Culture, Economics and Political Science, International Marketing). Courses are 45 hours of instruction. Accommodation can be organized with local families or at the university residences.

**Eligibility:** must be at least 16 years of age as well as obtain a Letter of Permission from your Faculty at UWO

**Duration:** from 2 weeks to a whole semester. Summer courses are available in July and August.

**Cost:** depending on the length of the stay and the courses chosen: starting at approximately \$560 for a 2 week course of 3 contact hours per day. More pricing information can be found here: <http://cursosinternacionales.usal.es/index.php/en/cursos-de-lengua-y-cultura/item/70-precios>

**Deadline:** fees must be paid 2 weeks before classes begin.

### • **Universidad de Granada, Spain**

Many levels of Spanish are offered, from beginner to advanced. Other courses such as Conversation, Business Spanish, and Civilization and Culture are also taught in Spanish.

**Eligibility:** obtain a letter of Permission from your Faculty at UWO

**Duration:** from 2 weeks to a whole academic semester.

**Cost:** for 80 hours of Intensive Spanish Language and Culture is approximately \$1,160 for the summer 2012; however cost depends on hours of instruction.

**Deadline:** Admission is carried out strictly on a first come, first served basis. If places are still available, students can register up to 2 days before the placement test.

- **Universidad de Guanajuato, Mexico**

The university offers a combination of Spanish Language instruction (from the beginners to the advanced level) and a cultural program with courses in history, literature, art history, folk art, dance, Mexican cuisine, etc. If the student's level of Spanish allows it, enrollment in any of the undergraduate programs the university offers is possible. Accommodation can be organized with local families.



**Eligibility:** obtain a Letter of Permission from your Faculty at UWO

**Duration:** depends on the program chosen: from a monthly course, to summer program or a whole academic semester.

**Cost:** depends on the program chosen. For example, the monthly program is approximately \$570 and the summer program is \$650. Registration fees may apply.

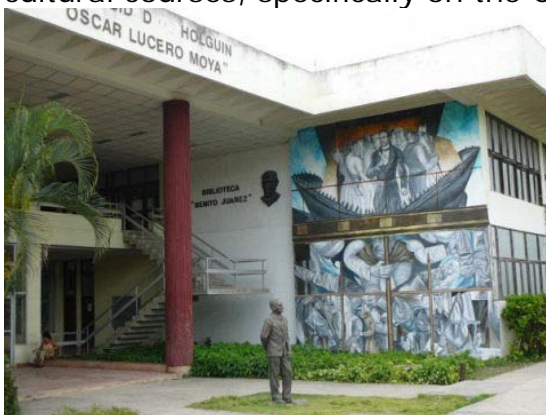

- **Universidad de Holguin, Cuba**

Different levels of the Spanish Language are available, along with a range of cultural courses, specifically on the Caribbean culture and cinema.



**Eligibility:** must have a student Visa and a Letter of Permission from your Faculty at UWO

**Duration:** from 2 to 6 weeks.

**Cost:** tuition for a half course: approx. \$202, full course: \$608. (2011 prices)

**Deadline:** early March

- **Universidad de Chile**



Organized by the Linguistics department in the Faculty of Philosophy and Humanities, a program of Spanish as a Foreign Language is offered for those who have a basis of the language, but need to improve both written and oral skills. There are four levels of language instruction: post-elementary, intermediate, post-intermediate, and advanced. The Universidad de Chile has no dormitories or housing facilities for visiting students; however, the Student Mobility Program offers information for lodging at private homes in the area.

**Eligibility:** minimum of 2 years of university study, and a level of command for Spanish suitable for academic work.

**Duration:** one semester (14 or 15 weeks; March-June or August-November).

**Cost:** inscription: \$223; Tuition: \$518 (approximate). The estimated cost for lodging and meals is \$622/month

- **Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México, Centro de Enseñanza para Extranjeros, different campus locations, Mexico**

Different levels of Spanish are offered, from the beginner to the advanced levels. Many content-based courses are taught in Spanish such as Mexican Art, History and Literature.

Accommodation can be organized with local families.

**Eligibility:** undergraduate or graduate students in any Faculty can apply

**Duration:** 1 term or a full year

**Cost:** UWO tuition fees

**Deadline:** Application must be made to UWO Exchange Office; check with that office regarding deadlines.

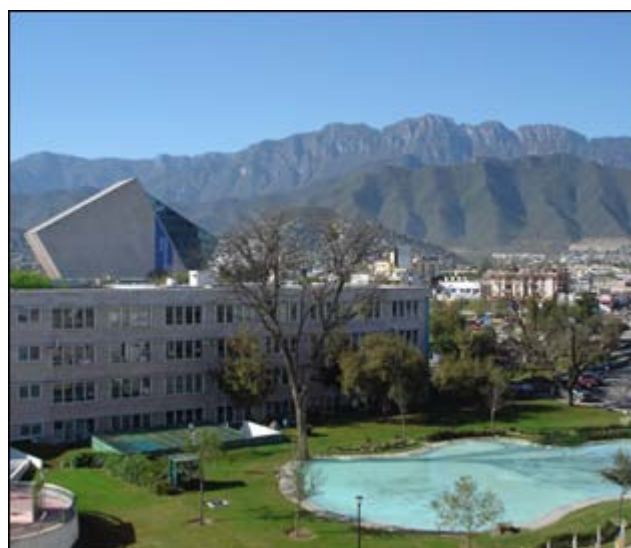

- **Tecnológico de Monterrey, Monterrey, Mexico**

You can take courses in Spanish and Mexican culture or other subjects taught in English, work with a company in Monterrey, or do an internship with a non-profit organization. Different housing options are offered (assigned on a first come first served basis upon receiving applications).



**Eligibility:** undergraduate students in the Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Engineering, Science and Social Science may apply. Those in other Faculties may apply, but will only earn elective credits towards their program.

**Duration:** summer, semester or year-long experience available.

**Cost:** UWO tuition fees.

**Deadline:** Application must be made to UWO Exchange Office; check with that office regarding deadlines.

- **Fundacion Universidad de las Americas, Mexico**



Courses are taught in Spanish, though UDLA offers nearly 50 different courses in English each semester. There are 5 residence buildings both on and off the campus. For a full list of courses, visit:

**Eligibility:** Undergraduate students in the Faculty of Arts and Humanities may apply. Students in other Faculties may apply, but should note

that courses taken may only count as electives, and not for credit in your program.

**Duration:** 1 term or 1 full year

**COST:** UWO tuition fees

**DEADLINE:** Application must be made to UWO Exchange Office; check with that office regarding deadlines.

**Eligibility:** graduate and undergraduate students within the Faculty of Social Science Department of Economics and Department of Management and Organizational Studies.

**Duration:** 1 semester or full year; Semester 1: Sept.-Dec., Semester 2: Jan.-May

**Cost:** UWO tuition fees

**Deadline:** Application must be made to UWO Exchange Office; check with that office regarding deadlines.

### III. Teaching English (or French) in Spain

#### Language and Culture Teaching Assistants in Spain

Share your native English or French language skills and knowledge of the North American culture throughout various locations in Spain. The teaching positions are offered for the grades K-12 in the public school system, and in public language schools. You will work 12-16 hours weekly.

**Eligibility:** university graduates or undergraduate students who have completed 2 full years of college or university study.

**Duration:** the program is 8 months long: from October to May.

**Grant:** a continuing education grant of approximately \$975/month is awarded for the duration of the program.

**Cost:** you are responsible for your own room and board as well as transportation to and from Spain

**Deadline:** applications accepted from the beginning of November through the end of March – apply as early as possible! The grants are given on a first-come first served basis among eligible applicants.
