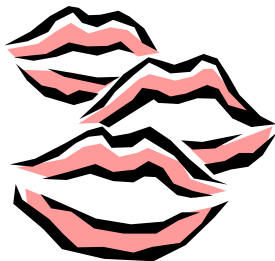
## What is Speechreading?

---

A method of communication in which the person perceives what is being said by watching the lip, tongue, and jaw movements of the speaker, in addition to observing the speaker's facial expression and body language. The focus is primarily on the speaker's lips.
