The new recruit will join the 3 full-time and several part-time members of the Section .

The Department of Paediatrics seeks an individual who will provide Excellence in clinical care and education to the Children's Hospital inpatient services. Specifically, the individual will assume the role of most responsible physician for inpatients admitted to the Clinical Teaching Unit (CTU) service. The CTU is a 24 bed unit that cares for a variety of general and subspecialty Paediatric patients admitted to the Children's Hospital. The team is made up of a General Academic Paediatrician, senior and junior Paediatric residents and medical students enrolled in the Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry. Candidates for this position will have an MD or equivalent degree and be eligible for licensing in the Province of Ontario. Specialist certification in Paediatrics through the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or equivalent is required.
