

Beginning September 1, 2017, Parking & Visitor Services is changing the process of how Accessible permits are administered.

What's Changing?

Annual permits on continuous monthly payroll deduction, including Accessible permits, will automatically be renewed.

When is this effective?

These new changes go into effect **September 1, 2017**

What does it mean for me?

Save time! Annual permits paid for on continuous monthly payroll deduction are automatically renewed.

Save money! Permit holders save 10% by choosing to pay for their permits through payroll deduction.

Stay up to date! The expiration date of your Accessible parking permit matches the expiration date of the MTO on file in the Parking office. New MTO information must be communicated to the Parking office to keep your permit active.

At this time, renewals for accessible permits cannot be done online. Permit holders still wishing to pay using a credit card will need to visit the Parking office.
