Please see the below June 30th shutdown scope of work.

Tuesday June 30th, as early as possible:

Shut down main switch board

- hydro isolates service conductors at transformer
- Arcon remove wire off main switch pull back to man hole and refeed into new switchboard
- tie in main Switchboard
- hydro metering to open meter cabinet
- Arcon to refeed meter cabinet out of new switchboard.
- tie in 3" emt into existing switch and pull wire from secondary of 300kva transformer
- tie in existing switch
- tie in 3/4" feeder into 600v panel P1F
- pull wire and tie in P1F

Emergency panel PLS1A and Node room panel PE1B will run on generator power for the duration of the change over. Estimated change over time 10h.

Note: There will be no normal power to the building for the duration of the change over. Approx. 10h.

Following the changeover:

- -Power will be back on to existing switchboard SW-1 via 300kva transformer.
- -Panel P1F will also be energized via new switchboard SW-2.
