Fire watch detail as per the attached service interruption as there wasn't space in the comments section for the entire protocol:

Contractor's plan to carry out the fire watch is as follows:

- Post notification signs regarding bell/alarm tests a minimum of 24 hours in advance
- Posting a body at the fire alarm panel to watch for alarms in other parts of the building
- Having a designated body in the zone being bypassed to monitor fire status as well as advise occupants of a fire in other zones
- The two will be in contact with each other immediately with two-way radios
