The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at The University of Western Ontario, London, Canada, invites applications for a faculty appointment in Water Resources Engineering with a focus in *hydraulic engineering* and/or *fluid dynamics*. The position is a three-year limited term appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor (or Associate Professor if qualifications and experience warrant) and is renewable subject to budget approval. The anticipated start date is July 1, 2012.

The successful candidate for the position will have a Ph.D. degree or equivalent in Water Resources Engineering, Civil and Environmental Engineering or other related engineering fields, and demonstrated outstanding research potential including an excellent publication record. (S)he will be expected to develop and sustain a vigorous research program, attract external research funding, supervise graduate students, and instruct undergraduate and graduate courses related to *environmental hydraulics design*, *municipal engineering design*, and *fluid mechanics*. Industrial experience is desirable, and eligibility for registration as a Professional Engineer in Ontario is required for this appointment. Applicants should also have excellent written and oral communication skills in English.
