

Lecturer Position

The **Richard Ivey School of Business** is recognized worldwide for the quality of its management education and research. The School's major activities include: a highly regarded MBA program and undergraduate program; a well established doctoral program active in most major areas of management; as well as, an expanding portfolio of programs for executives, including an Executive MBA delivered in Canada and Hong Kong. The School is internationally oriented in terms of curricula, research, faculty, and student exchanges.

Limited term full-time appointment contracts for two years in either Business 2257 or Business 1220E are available effective May 7, 2012. Both courses are managed by Ivey and are taught to the larger university community. Business 2257 is a required course for Ivey's selective undergraduate (HBA) program. Applications are invited from individuals who have graduated from either a four-year honours program in commerce/business administration or from an MBA program. Experience and familiarity with the case method is preferred.

Lecturers are expected to teach up to four sections of Business 2257 or Business 1220E respectively during the winter and/or summer academic sessions in each of their two years, using the case method of instruction. Lecturers are expected to write at least two cases with comprehensive teaching notes for the Business 2257 or Business 1220E course. Lecturers are responsible for all activities related to teaching the course such as student counselling, and administrative activities such as curriculum development, writing and setting of exams, managing competitions, training new Lecturers, managing and recruiting teaching assistants, etc. New Lecturers train during the Summer Intersession Business 2257 and Business 1220E course (May and June of 2012). Lecturers will be required to attend training and teaching workshops.

These positions are subject to budget approval. Applicants should have fluent written and oral communication skills in English. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority. The Richard Ivey School of Business and The University of Western Ontario are committed to employment equity and welcomes applications from all qualified women and men, including visible minorities, aboriginal people and persons with disabilities.

Please include in your submission an application letter with resume; a transcript of your grades received in your last three full years at university; a detailed description of your experience with the case method; and recommendation letters from two professors regarding your teaching potential.

Submission deadline is **Thursday, September 29, 2011**, although applications will be accepted until the position has been filled. Applicants are encouraged to apply as early as possible.
