JOINT APPOINTMENT

The **Richard Ivey School of Business & Faculty of Health Sciences, the University of Western Ontario** invite applications for a **Probationary Tenure-track or Tenured** joint appointment in the area of **Health Innovation and Leadership**. The position is appointed in the Richard Ivey School of Business with a joint appointment to the Faculty of Health Sciences, School of Health Studies.

The successful candidate will hold a Ph.D. in Health Sciences, Business, or a related field. Applicants must demonstrate an exemplary teaching record and enthusiasm for teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Priority will be given to candidates who have an established research record in one of the following areas of health sector research: leadership, innovation, information technology, partnerships or commercialization. Ideally, the successful candidate will complement existing areas of research strength within the Faculty of Health Sciences and further strengthen the Ivey Centre for Health Innovation and Leadership's teaching, research and policy development initiatives. Preference will be given to applicants with a proven track record in securing funding grants, demonstrated proficiency interfacing between business and government on health related issues, and academic experience in both a health sciences and business school environment. Demonstrated experience leading multidisciplinary research teams with health sector partners, national and international level research partnerships would be advantageous.

The position entails undergraduate teaching and curriculum development related to health innovation, leadership and cross-sector partnerships in the Faculty of Health Sciences. The candidate will be expected to provide leadership in curriculum design and delivery in the Ivey MBA Health Sector Stream, as well as the HBA Program. In addition to teaching responsibilities, the ideal candidate would assume a leadership role in the Ivey Centre for Health Innovation and Leadership (ICHIL) (www.ivey.uwo.ca/ichil). The Centre's mandate is to prepare health leaders with the skills they need to identify, assess and facilitate the adoption of innovative technologies, systems and processes that health care systems need in order to be sustainable.

The **Richard Ivey School of Business** (www.ivey.uwo.ca) is recognized worldwide for the quality of its management education and research. The School's major activities include: a highly regarded MBA program and undergraduate program; a well established doctoral program active in most major areas of management; as well as, an expanding portfolio of programs for executives, including an Executive MBA delivered in Canada and Hong Kong. The Canadian Executive MBA facilities are located at the Exchange Tower in downtown Toronto. The Asia campus is located at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Center.

The **School of Health Studies** (www.uwo.ca/fhs/health_studies/index.html) is one of 6 schools in the **Faculty of Health Sciences** (www.uwo.ca/fhs/). The School is interdisciplinary in nature and has committed partnerships with leading practice centres in the city and region. Educational and research programs are supported through excellent relationships with health care and community agencies. The School attracts over 2400 applicants annually for one of the available 300 Year 1 undergraduate positions. There are currently over 1200 undergraduate students enrolled in the School of Health Studies.
