ACADEMIC POSITION DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICINE

The Department of Medicine, Division of Emergency Medicine, Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, at The University of Western Ontario, and its affiliated hospitals are seeking six physicians for full-time clinical academic appointment to The University of Western Ontario (UWO). Applicants should be certified, or eligible for certification, by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, College of Family Physicians of Canada – Emergency Medicine or equivalent. Candidates must have an MD or equivalent, and must be eligible for licensure in the province of Ontario.

The Division of Emergency Medicine currently consists of 51 academic Emergency clinician educators / researchers. The current group prides itself on excellent clinical care, a growing research program and outstanding education. Clinical care is provided at London Health Sciences Centre's (LHSC) 2 Academic Emergency Departments and the St. Joseph's Health Care London (SJHC) Urgent Care Centre. Clinical Remuneration for Emergency Department work is based on an Alternate Funding Agreement. The Urgent Care Centre is a Fee for Service model. Twenty-four abstracts were presented at the 2011 Canadian Association of Emergency Physicians Conference. Successful applicants will be expected to teach at the Undergraduate and Graduate level. The practice plan remunerates education and research on a points based system. There are also numerous administrative opportunities at LHSC, SJHC and UWO.

The University of Western Ontario is situated in picturesque London, Ontario, a city of approximately 360,000 along the banks of the Thames River. The City of London is a vibrant community with many family-friendly amenities and has one of the lowest cost of living rates in Ontario.
