Applications are invited for a full time position in the Division of Maternal Fetal Medicine in the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, The University of Western Ontario. The Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology is an academic department fully immersed in a range of educational and research programs and providing women's health care services for London and the surrounding Southwestern Ontario region.

Rank will be determined by experience and qualifications at the time of the appointment. This is a Clinical Academic appointment and candidates must hold an MD degree, specialty certification in Obstetrics & Gynaecology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or equivalent, have completed training in Maternal Fetal Medicine, and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario. The candidate is expected to join the clinical practice within the Maternal Fetal Medicine Division and will participate in the medical educational programs of The University of Western Ontario. It is expected that the candidate will also have an active research or administrative focus with approximately 40% time available for clinical/basic science research, teaching and/or administrative activity. Salary is commensurate with experience and training.

The academic environment of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology includes the CIHR Team in Fetal Growth Restriction: Mechanisms and Outcomes, of which five members of the Maternal Fetal Medicine Division are members with major involvement in both Clinical and Basic Science research. London is the site of approximately 6,000 births per year with all tertiary care clinical and research facilities available.
