ACADEMIC POSITIONS (2) - DIVISION OF RESPIROLOGY

The Department of Medicine, Division of Respiriology, Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry, at The University of Western Ontario, and its affiliated hospitals are seeking 2 Respiriologists for full-time clinical academic appointment to The University of Western Ontario. Applicants should be certified, or eligible for certification in Respiriology, by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent. Candidates must have an MD or equivalent, and must be eligible for licensure in the province of Ontario.

The job description for these positions may involve up to 75% time commitment to research, with the remainder divided between clinical practice and teaching. Administrative responsibilities will be minimal.

The successful applicant(s) would be expected to augment research in the areas of sleep and breathing disorders or clinical/outcomes research in airways diseases, including new techniques of lung imaging (in conjunction with Robarts Research Institute).
