

What's going where – a guide to change on campus

ABOUT THIS GUIDE

Many projected costs and completion dates are estimates only and are subject to budget approvals, financing arrangements and a complex planning process. This map is suitable only as a general guide and is subject to change. In addition, projects outlined here fall into two main categories: those already approved by the Board of Governors and projects proposed for the upcoming university budget.

Bio-Engineering Building replacement - for 2006-07 budget approval

Current building built 40 years ago as temporary building. Houses groups from Chemical/Biochemical Engineering. Would feature equivalent space although successful CFI proposal would provide additional floor. **Completion: 2008**

Althouse renovation - for 2006-07 budget approval

Study completed. Renovations would include replacement of the HVAC system, modifications to exterior envelope, upgrades to interior. **Completion: 2008**

Student Recreational Facility - subject to student vote

Planning stage. South end of South Valley site, linked to Thompson Centre. To feature five or six gyms, 50-metre pool, fitness/weight facilities, recreational squash courts, locker rooms, offices for University's Sports & Recreation Services. Frees space in UCC for student club space and classrooms. **Completion: 2008**

Student Services renovation - for 2006-07 budget approval

Relocation of Physical Plant to proposed Support Services building allows consolidation of all student services in Services Building including Registrar's Office, Centre for New Students and Student Development Centre. Single point of contact for many student services. **Completion: 2009**

Lawson and Stevenson renovation - for 2006-07 budget approval

Exit of Human Resources, Financial Services, Institutional Planning & Budgeting, Internal Audit, Research Western and Registrar permits reconfiguration of Lawson and Stevenson buildings - space for academic purposes. **Completion: 2011**

UCC renovation (University-controlled space) - for 2006-07 budget approval

Relocation of Campus Recreation and Student Development Centre to proposed recreational facility and current Physical Plant building opens space for small- and medium-sized general classrooms. **Completion: 2010**

Support Services - for 2006-07 budget approval

Design contract approved. New building to house Physical Plant, Human Resources, Financial Services, Institutional Planning & Budgeting, Information Technology Services, Internal Audit and Research Western. Frees space in Natural Sciences, current Physical Plant and Stevenson-Lawson. **Completion: 2008**

New Ivey School - for 2006-07 budget approval

Would house HBA and PhD programs. Substantial increases planned for HBA program. University and Ivey fundraising to cover cost - contingent on fundraising revenues. **Completion: 2012**

Current Ivey School renovation - for 2006-07 budget approval

Renovations to current Ivey building would follow construction of new Ivey School building. Would provide campus core academic space. **Completion: 2013**

Physics & Astronomy renovation - for 2006-07 budget approval

Modernization to replace rusted lintels and windows, roof and ventilators, asbestos removal, mechanical and electrical systems, lab furnishings, fumehoods and modifications of layout. **Completion: 2011**

The Biotron - approved

Under construction. Will create world-class environmental science and climate change research facility. **Completion: 2007**

New Science Building - approved

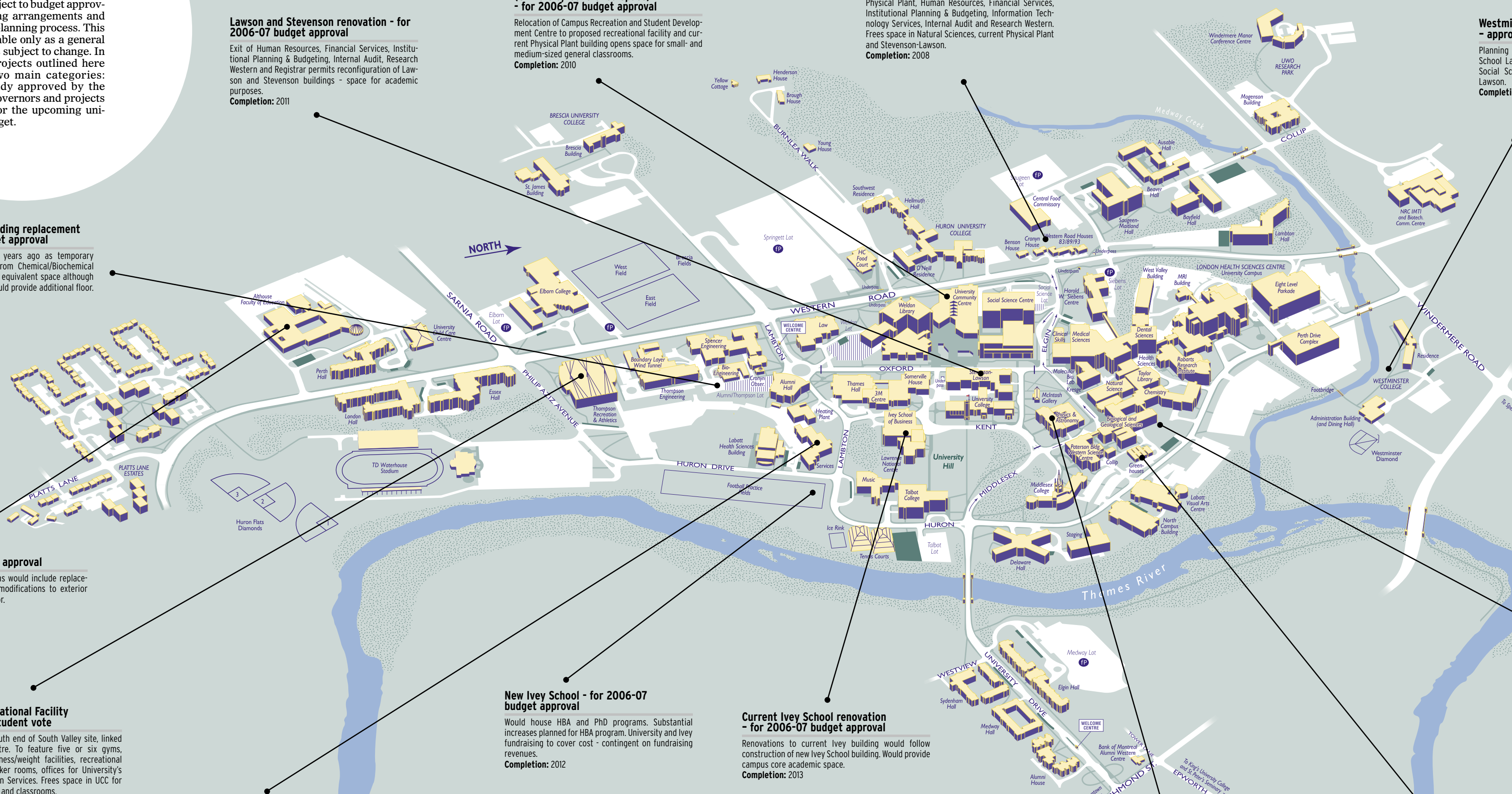
Planning stage. Undergraduate instructional laboratories, graduate student space, faculty office space and research space for Chemistry and Physics & Astronomy. **Completion: 2007**

Spencer Hall renovation/expansion - approved

Planning: Starting in 2007-08, Ivey to offer MBA program at Spencer Hall. Provides instructional and students space. **Completion: 2007**

Westminster College renovations - approved

Planning stage. Two research groups, University Pre-School Laboratory, External portfolio. Frees space in Social Science Centre, Alumni Hall and Stevenson-Lawson. **Completion: 2007**
