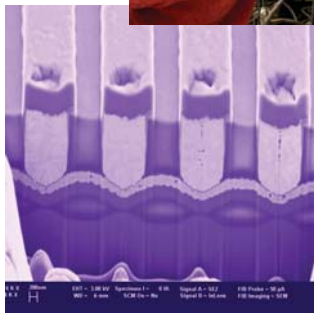
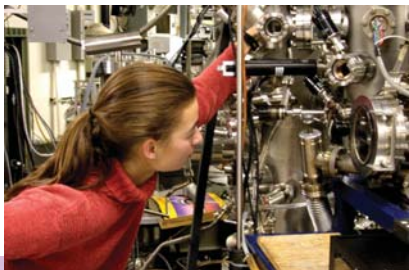




Western Institute for Nanomaterials Science 2nd ONE-DAY WORKSHOP Friday, March 24, 2006



The Western Institute for Nanomaterials Science (WINS) was established in 2004 as an Institute to highlight and to provide direction to Western's research strengths in materials and biomaterials, particularly on the nanoscale and in the emerging field of nanotechnology. This will be the theme of our 2nd one-day workshop. It will reflect the strongly interdisciplinary and collaborative nature of nanomaterials science, bringing experts together from many different departments at Western. The workshop will consist of 9 invited technical talks by speakers from across the University and by F. Himpfel (University of Wisconsin) and G. Botton (McMaster University). In addition there will be two sessions of poster presentations.
