SOME HISTORICAL NOTES

Grade Points:

In January 2002 (S.02-10), Senate approved the withdrawal of the grade point system and the implementation of new progression requirements. The Senate agenda item can be seen by clicking on the following link:

As a result, effective September 1, 2002, the regulation on Grade Points and Letter Grades below was rescinded and replaced.

GRADE POINTS AND LETTER GRADES (S.951.1, S.2088.1)

<i>Full Course</i>	<i>Half Course</i>	<i>Letter Grade</i>	<i>Percentage Range</i>
5	2.5	A+	90 - 100
4	2	A	80 - 89
3	1.5	B	70 - 79
2	1	C	60 - 69
1	0.5	D	50 - 59
0	0	F	0 - 49

For all purposes at this University, grades will be rounded off to the nearest whole number with .5 rounded up in accordance with common practice. "Grades" mean both grades and averages.
