Convocation Board Policy Regarding Hooding of Graduating Students

Faculty members at The University of Western Ontario and other recognized universities will be permitted to hood immediate family members and PhD supervisors will be permitted to hood their doctoral candidates provided that arrangements are made with the Marshal of Convocation (see contact information above) at least one week before the relevant convocation ceremony.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Those participating in the Academic Procession will be provided with academic regalia [Western colors], free of charge, from a location in the North Corridor of Alumni Hall, just prior to lining up for the procession. Or call the Assistant Convocation Coordinator at x84540 with the following information: highest degree, height (wearing shoes), hat size [mortarboard is optional].

Regalia **must be returned immediately** following convocation to the same location in the North Corridor of Alumni Hall (**not** the temporary bookstore location for students). This regalia is not provided for use at Faculty awards ceremonies.
