Kim was born in Penang, Malaysia, and immigrated to London England as a young boy. He set out to see the world at the age of 21 and eventually settled in Vancouver, BC, in the early 70s. Kim played in various bands and was active in the music scene and the early punk movement in Vancouver. He moved with his long time partner, Susan Edelstein, to London, Ontario in 2003. Kim made an important contribution to students, staff and faculty at Western through his dedication, his keen photographic eye, his talent for gallery presentation, and his good-humoured patience.

Kim Clarke, an unassuming gentle soul, singersongwriter, photographer, and dog-lover will be sadly missed but not forgotten.
