2. To qualify for the Certificate in Writing, students must achieve an overall average of 70% in 3.5 courses:

0.5 course (required): Writing 2299F/G Re-Visioning Self: Creating Your Professional Portfolio

and

3.0 Writing courses numbered 2200 and above.
