Climate change impacts in the north with a focus on terrestrial arthropods

Climate change is occurring at a rapid rate in northern environments and understanding the impacts, and working towards developing meaningful adaptation actions requires collaborative, cross-disciplinary efforts. I will present work from my research on Arctic terrestrial arthropods from the Yukon Territory and Greenland. I will then highlight and discuss my current work, which focusses on everything from climate change impacts and adaptation in Newfoundland to understanding moth biodiversity patterns in the boreal forest.
