The good, the bad, and the ugly: Exploring invasion genetics of high-risk invasive plants in the US mid-Atlantic with undergrads

An introduced lineage of the common reed, Phragmites australis, has been aggressively invading estuarine habitats throughout North America for ca. 150 years. In this talk, I'll share how these invasions have provided a way to engage undergraduate students in cutting-edge, interdisciplinary research that directly impacts the management of Virginia's natural resources.
