**Neuroimaging studies of binocular vision:
States, traits, debates**

I will discuss fMRI and MEG studies of binocular rivalry including some quite recent work on individual differences. One theme is comparison of well-matched binocular states such as different types of rivalry and depth. Another theme is the non-invasive measurement of interocular inhibition which may possibly be a partially heritable trait. There is also some context of how this could relate to binocular vision disorders such as amblyopia.
