Ontario Student Assistant Program Residency Guidelines

* A student and his or her family must meet one of the following criteria: (i) The student has lived in Ontario for at least 12 months in a row up to the beginning of his or her full-time post-secondary studies; (ii) A student's spouse has lived in Ontario for at least 12 months in a row up to the beginning of the student's current period of studies and the student's spouse was not enrolled in full-time post-secondary studies during this 12-month period; (iii) Student(s), parent(s), stepparent(s), legal guardian(s), or official sponsor(s) have lived (or maintained the family home) in Ontario for at least 12 months in a row up to the beginning of the student's current period of studies.

Students living abroad are considered residents of Ontario if they (or in the case of single dependent students, their parents) last lived in Ontario for at least 12 consecutive months before going abroad. Single dependent students whose parents are separated or divorced, will be considered to be residents of Ontario, if Ontario is the province of residence of the parent with whom the student normally resides.
