

## HONORS SPECIALIZATION IN CREATIVE WRITING AND ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE

**Admission Requirements:** Completion of first-year requirements with no failures. Students must have an average of at least 70% in 3.0 principal courses, including:

- a) **Writing 1000F/G;** and
- b) **2.0 additional courses** including 1.0 course from English 1020E, 1022E, 1024E, 1035E, 1036E, or both of English 1027F/G and 1028F/G; and 1.0 course from Classical Studies 1000, Film Studies 1020E, Film Studies 1022, French 1900E, Philosophy 1020, Visual Arts Studio 1020, Women's Studies 1020E or both of Women's Studies 1021F/G and 1022F/G, Visual Arts History 1040 or two of Visual Arts History 1041A/B, 1042A/B, 1043A/B, 1044A/B and 1045A/B, the former Comparative Literature and Culture 1020.
- c) **0.5 additional course.** A minimum mark of 70% in Writing 1000F/G is required, with no mark below 60% in the other principal courses; and submission of:
- d) **A portfolio.**

**4.0 Writing courses:**

- 0.5 course in Writing Genres** from: Writing 2204F/G, 2214F/G, 2218F/G, 2220F/G.
- 1.5 courses** from: Writing 2203F/G, 2211F/G, 4998F/G (or the former Writing 2299F/G).
- 2.0 courses** from: Writing 2213F/G, 2219F/G, 2222F/G, 2223F/G, 2224F/G, 2225F/G, 2226F/G, 2227F/G, 3225F/G, 3228F/G (or the former Writing 2217F/G). A 0.5 course in Special Topics in Writing may be substituted with permission of the Department. Note: Students may enroll in Creative Writing Genre courses not previously taken in order to fulfill this part of the module.

**6.0 English courses:**

- 1.0 course in a Survey of Literary Traditions** from: ENG 2301E, 2401E, 2501E, 2601E; **or the former ENG 2307E, 2308E, 2309E, 2310E.**
- 1.0 course in Theory** from: ENG 2200 to ENG 2260, ENG 3200 to ENG 3210, TS 3205F/G.
- 1.0 course in Pre-1800 Literature** from: ENG 3300 to ENG 3349, ENG 3440 to ENG 3449, ENG 3540 to ENG 3549, ENG 3640 to ENG 3649; **or the former ENG 3001, 3012, 3115E, 3116E, 3224E, 3226E, 3227E, 3228F/G (but not ENG 3333E (Huron), 3444E, 3446F/G).**
- 1.0 course in Post-1800 Literature** from: ENG 3350 to ENG 3399, ENG 3450 to ENG 3499, ENG 3550 to ENG 3599, ENG 3650 to ENG 3699, ENG 3700 to ENG 3799, ENG 3850 to ENG 3899; **or the former ENG 3444E, 3446F/G.**
- 1.5 additional courses** from: ENG 2000 to ENG 3999; 0.5 of this requirement may be substituted from Medieval Studies or Theatre Studies numbered 2200 to 3999; this requirement must include at least 0.5 from ENG 3000 to 3999.
- 0.5 course** from: ENG 4000 to ENG 4990.

**1.0 Capstone:**

- 1.0 additional course** from: ENG 4000 to ENG 4999 or WRI 4000 to WRI 4999.
