

MINOR IN ENGLISH FOR TEACHERS

Admission Requirements: Completion of first-year requirements, including 1.0 from ENG 1000 to ENG 1999 with a mark of at least 60%. Students should consult with the Department prior to admission.

Module Requirements: 5.0 courses

- 1.0 course in Shakespeare** from: ENG 3330E, 3331F/G, 3332F/G or 3337E; **or the former ENG 3227E.**
- 1.0 course in Canadian Literature** from: ENG 2060E, 2501E or ENG 3550 to ENG 3599; **or the former ENG 2309E, 3777F/G.**
- 1.0 course in Popular Literature** from: ENG 2033E, 2071F/G, 2072F/G, 2110E; **or the former 2500E.**
- 1.0 course in National Traditions** from: ENG 2301E, 2401E or 2601E; **or the former ENG 2307E, 2308E, 2310E.**
- 1.0 additional essay course** in ENG at the 2000 level and above. (Students are recommended to include Writing 2101F/G or equivalent in this category.)

Note: ENG 2033E is recommended for teaching Primary to Intermediate grades and ENG 2110E (or the former ENG 2500E) for Intermediate to Senior levels.
