

Primary Health Care System (PHCS) Program Research Fellowships 2012-2013

Background:

The Primary Health Care System (PHCS) Program is a province-wide network dedicated to providing evidence-based advice to the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-term Care (MOHLTC), hereafter referred to as 'Ministry', as well as participating collaboratively with PHCS researchers across Ontario.

GOAL: the goal of this program is to create a community of Ontario PHCS researchers available to respond to MOHLTC priorities, to share research ideas and innovations, and to integrate the PHCS research being conducted and planned for the future

The PHCS is dedicated to building research capacity in primary health care research and will therefore be offering Research Fellowships.

Criteria for accessing PHCS Research Fellowship funding:

- The project needs to focus on areas of research related to the primary health care system
- The applicant must be enrolled in a Canadian University or completed their graduate studies in the last 5 years
- Research Fellowship projects must meet the usual requirements for approval by a Research Ethics Board (or equivalent organization) if applicable.
- If you are successful in this competition, you must be willing to report your grants to the PHCS Program to include in reports to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care
- The applicant must reside in Ontario

Selection Criteria:

- Academic level/years of experience
- Relevance to primary health care
- Feasibility of the proposed project

DEADLINE: 7, SEPT 2012

The funding allotted to each fellowship will be \$10 000 and will run from September 1, 2012 to March 31, 2013
