

## What is Practice-Based Research (PBR)?



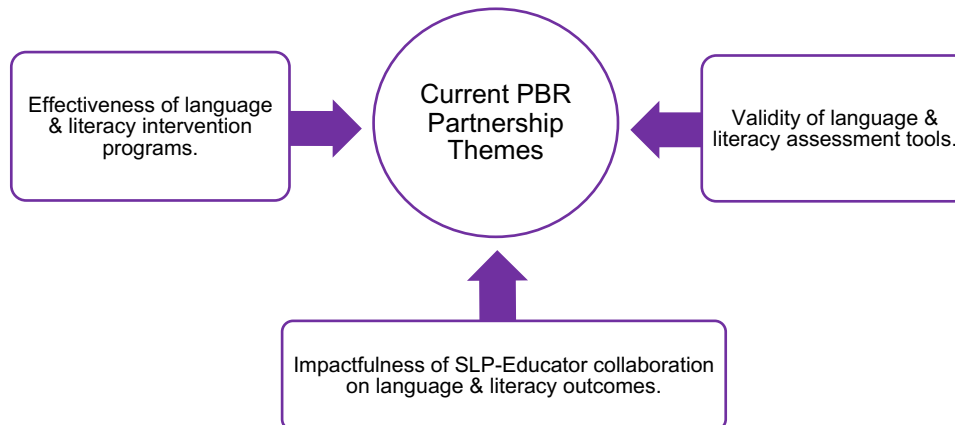
- Collaborative work between researchers and clinicians
