

**Award Description**

Awarded annually to full-time graduate Nursing students whose studies are focussed on any aspect of long-term care of the elderly and who have demonstrated financial need. Preference will be given to one student studying at the Master's level, and one at the Doctoral level. An application form outlining both financial need and involvement in studies related to the long-term care of the elderly, must be completed. This application form is available online through the School of Nursing Graduate Program website. The Scholarships and Awards Committee in Nursing will select the recipients in consultation with at least one faculty member who holds membership in the School of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies. These bursaries were established by a bequest with Foundation Western by Helen Fasken (BSc'42, Nursing). In 1974, Helen was chosen by her colleagues (through the Registered Nurses Association of Ontario) as one of twelve nurses considered 'The Most Caring Nurse' in the Province. Many programs, including Well-Baby Clinics, Mental Health services, Immunization programs, Public Health Nursing visits and Home Care were developed in Wellington County with Helen's guidance.
