



Accepted English Language Proficiency Exemptions for Master of Science in Occupational Therapy program at Western University.

You may be exempt from providing Proof of English Language Proficiency if you meet one of the criteria's listed below;

- 1- Completing a university degree* for at least two years in a country where English is the official language.

Countries: **Canada, USA, UK, Australia and New Zealand**

*Includes undergraduate students completing at least final two years of their undergraduate program and students completing a minimum two-year graduate program.

- 2- Completing a full-time undergraduate degree for at least 4 years at a university where English is the medium of instruction, in a country where English is AN official language.

Countries: **Barbados, Botswana, Ghana, Guyana, Jamaica, Kenya, Lesotho, Liberia, Malawi, Malta, Namibia, Nigeria, Papua New Guinea, Sierra Leone, Singapore, South Africa, Swaziland, Tanzania, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Hong Kong, Vanuatu, Turks and Caicos Islands, Solomon Islands, Seychelles, St. Vincent and Grenadines, St. Lucia, St. Kitts and Lewis, Monserrat, Mauritius, Guam, Grenada, Gibraltar, Gambia, Fiji, Falkland Islands, Eswatini, Dominica, Cayman Islands, Cameroon, British Virgin islands, Bermuda, Bahamas, Belize, Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda.**

- 3- Completing a 4-year undergraduate degree at a university or program where English is the medium of instruction**, in a country where English is not an official language.

**Certificate of confirmation from originating institution required.

- *If your Country of Education has English as an official language but not listed above, please check with the program to determine the eligibility of your exemption.*
