### What is a module?

Modules are programs of study

 E.g. Major, Minor, Specialization, Honours Specialization

Why do I need one?

## Degree Types

Four-year degree = 20.0 credits

Honours (70% avg., no failures, no required Health Science module courses w/grades <60%)

Non-honours (60% cumulative, no fails)

Three-year degree = 15.0 credits

## Health Sciences with Biology Progression Requirements

#### HONOURS SPECIALIZATION IN HEALTH SCIENCES WITH BIOLOGY

In order to progress after first year, students must achieve the following:

Minimum grade of 70% in each of Health Sciences 1001A/B, 1002A/B, 1111A/B and 1300A/B

Minimum grade of 60% in Biology 1001A and 1002B

Minimum grade of 60% in each of Chemistry 1301A and 1302B

Minimum cumulative average of 70%

No course grade below 50% in any subject

NOTE: Due to the limited spaces available in the programs offered by the School of Health Studies, meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.

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In order to progress in the Honours Specialization in Health Sciences with Biology after second year, students must achieve the following:

Minimum cumulative modular average of 70% No course grade below 50% in any subject

## Health Sciences/Rehab Science Progression Requirements

In order to progress into the Major or Specialization in **Health Sciences/Rehabilitation Science** after first year, students must achieve the following:

- Minimum grade of 60% in each of Health Sciences 1001A/B, 1002A/B, 1111A/B and 1300A/B
- Minimum grade of 60% in Biology 1201A and 1202B (or Biology 1001A and 1002B)
- Minimum cumulative average of 65%

In order to progress in the Honors Specialization in **Health Sciences/Rehabilitation Science** after first year, student must achieve the following:

- Minimum grade of 70% in each of Health Sciences 1001A/B, 1002A/B, 1111A/B and 1300A/B
- Minimum grade of 60% in Biology 1201A and 1202B (or Biology 1001A and 1002B)
- Minimum cumulative average of 70%
- No course grade below 50% in any subject

NOTE: Due to the limited spaces available in the programs offered by the School of Health Studies, meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.

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In order to progress in the Honours Specialization in Health Science after second year, students must achieve the following:

- Minimum cumulative modular average of 70%
- No course grade below 50% in any subject

## Which program do I choose?

- If you wish to continue in SHS, Health Science must be your first choice
- If you don't qualify for your first choice in HS, we will place you in the next highest level module for which you qualify
- Think about courses you enjoyed this year and research programs related to those courses
- When researching a program (via the Academic Calendar https://www.westerncalendar.uwo.ca/), you are checking to see if:
  - 1. You have the prerequisite courses
  - 2. You would be interested in the courses throughout the module
  - 3. You meet progression (average) requirements for that program

#### **Health Science with Bio**

This module is ideal for students who want to pursue careers in medicine and dentistry.

#### **Rehabilitation Sciences**

Students wishing to pursue careers in Physical Therapy or Occupational Therapy find the modules in Rehabilitation Sciences offer an excellent knowledge foundation that they can build upon in their graduate studies.

#### **Health Science**

Covers all of the above, dependent on your elective choices.

#### **Dual Degree with Ivey Business**

ideal choice for students who see themselves pursuing careers in healthcare administration, health management, and health entrepreneurship.

## Nursing

As a current Western student, you can "apply" to the nursing program by completing the Intent to Register (ITR) process in March; there will be a Nursing-specific ITR link available at that time. Since this is a separate ITR application form, it will not impact ITR for your current program and/or your ability to apply to graduate. Adjudication will take place in May, and students will be notified of the status of their request once adjudication is complete.

Note: students must have all the required pre-requisites by 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025

#### STEP ONE – select your course load



#### Intent to Register 2025/2026 TEST - Step 1

Intent to Register (ITR) is for current Fall/Winter students to request registration in an academic program and/or module for the next Fall/Winter term.

ITR is used to indicate your academic preference for:

Program and/or Module(s)

For ITR deadlines and additional information refer to the Office of the Registrar website under Academics > Grades, Progression and Graduation > Intent to Register

After submitting your ITR, a confirmation email will be sent to your Western email account.

Note: Some students will not be eligible to submit an online ITR. Contact your current home Faculty Academic Counselling Office for further information if you cannot submit an online ITR.






If you select Western Scholars and did not achieve the necessary grades you will be put in the next highest module available.

Non-Honors if you do not achieve necessary grades.




Step four -Select your degree path whether you are doing just health science or wish to do a dual degree based on your program choice


