

## Major in Rehabilitation Sciences – 2024 Enrolment Onwards – 20.0 Credits

To progress into the Major in Rehabilitation Sciences after first year, students must achieve the following:

Students must have a minimum cumulative average of 65%, with a minimum grade of 60% in each of: Health Sciences 1001A/B, Health Sciences 1002A/B, Health Sciences 1111A/B, Health Sciences 1300A/B, and Biology 1001A and Biology 1002B. Enrolment is limited. Meeting the minimum requirement does not guarantee admission.
