

EXPOSURE PROCEDURE SUMMARY SHEET

****IMMEDIATELY COMMENCE FIRST AID**
*MUST BE WITHIN 2 MINUTES OF INJURY***

FOR SKIN INJURIES

**Flush the wound with diluted bleach
Scrub the wound with chohexidine soap and water for 15 minutes**

FOR MUCUS MEMBRANE EXPOSURE (EYES, MOUTH)

Immediately irrigate the contaminated area for 15 minutes using the nearest a portable eyewash device, a fixed eyewash station, or tap water.

If another individual is present they should retrieve the Human Post Exposure Kit, assist the exposed employee, and contact the Facility Manger and an ACVS Veterinarian

Locate a Primate Exposure Sampling Kit

**Swab the exposure site on the individual
If exposure is from an object that will fit into a collection container place the object into the container
If the exposure is from a large object such as a cage, swab the item**

Seek medical attention
