IN LONDON

- The best way to travel across London is by using [bus](#).
- Buses run very frequently and can take you pretty much everywhere in town.
- As a grad student, a bus pass is included in your tuition.



SOGS BUS PASS PROGRAM



- All full-time SOGS members are **automatically enrolled** in the bus pass program each term (September, January, May).
- If you are a full-time graduate student who is on co-op your bus pass eligibility depends on your tuition during your co-op term:
 - If you pay full-time fees while on co-op, you are eligible for a bus pass during your co-op term.
 - If you pay part-time fees while on co-op, you are not eligible for a bus pass during your co-op term
- Your WesternONE Student card functions as your tap bus pass AND student card

- If you like the train, [Via Rail](#) is the way to go.
 - 205 York St.
 - Tickets are cheaper when purchased in advance and on **Tuesday's**
- If you prefer the bus, several intercity services connect London to Toronto and beyond.
 - **Megabus** — departs from Western University (Elgin Hall)
 - **FlixBus** — departs from Western University; Wi-Fi and power outlets onboard
 - **Intercity Bus** — departs from 101 York street, intercity bus terminal
 - **Poparide** — ride sharing app
 - **Onex Bus** — departs from Western University (Elgin Hall)
