WELCOME TO CANADA, EH!

- Well, you're moving to Canada, so you know what to expect...
- ...or not?
- Follow us into our four distinct and beautiful seasons: Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer



FALL: SEPTEMBER 22 TO DECEMBER 21

- Fall brings cool weather and snow can start falling as early as November
- Average Temperatures: between 10°C and 12°C.
- **Outdoor Activities:** Harvest festivals happen throughout Middlesex County to celebrate the end of the growing season. In October, Canadians celebrate Thanksgiving - a holiday where we give thanks for the good life we enjoy

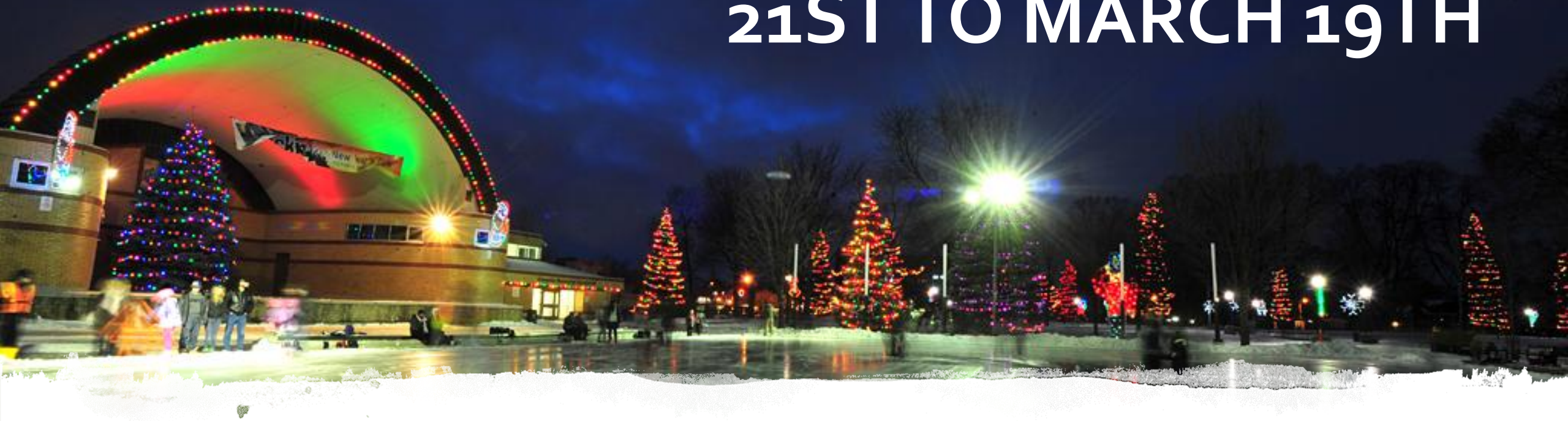


FALL: SEPTEMBER 22 TO DECEMBER 21

- **Type of Clothing to Wear:** Lightweight jackets or sweaters and long-sleeved shirts.



WINTER: DECEMBER 21ST TO MARCH 19TH



- Get ready for the world-famous Canadian cold!
- Average Temperatures: -6°C (but it can often get much colder.)
- Snowfall: 200 cm (80 inches) over the whole season.



WINTER: DECEMBER 21 TO MARCH 19

- **Outdoor Activities:** Skating, snowmobiling, skiing and snowboarding. Boler Mountain in London offers ski and snowboard runs right in the city.
- **Type of Clothing to Wear:** Heavy coat, sweater, gloves, winter boots and warm hat.





SPRING: MARCH 20 TO JUNE 20

- Spring is a great time to see all of the trees and flowers bloom in the many parks and green spaces around the city and county.
- **Average Temperatures:** Ranges from around 4°C in March to 20°C by late June, with cooler nights
- **Outdoor Activities:** Enjoy a nature walk.



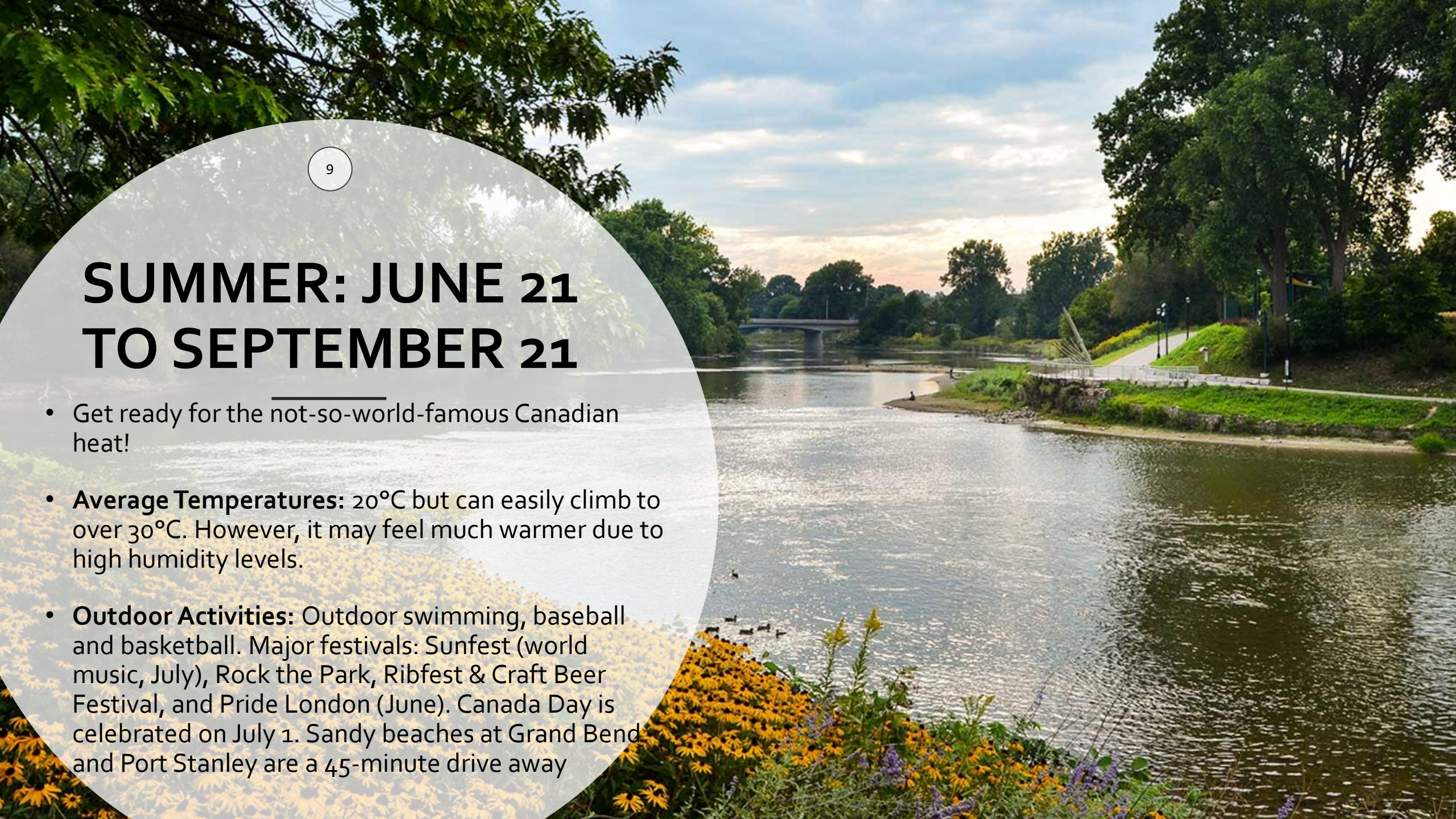
SPRING: MARCH 20 TO JUNE 20

- **Type of Clothing to Wear:** A jacket, hat, gloves and boots.
- **For rainy days:** Raincoat, rubber boots and umbrella are handy



SUMMER: JUNE 21 TO SEPTEMBER 21

- Get ready for the not-so-world-famous Canadian heat!
- **Average Temperatures:** 20°C but can easily climb to over 30°C. However, it may feel much warmer due to high humidity levels.
- **Outdoor Activities:** Outdoor swimming, baseball and basketball. Major festivals: Sunfest (world music, July), Rock the Park, Ribfest & Craft Beer Festival, and Pride London (June). Canada Day is celebrated on July 1. Sandy beaches at Grand Bend and Port Stanley are a 45-minute drive away



SUMMER: JUNE 21 TO SEPTEMBER 21

- **Type of Clothing to Wear:** Dresses, shorts, short-sleeved shirts and sandals. Shorts are not worn in most workplaces. A light jacket or sweater for cooler nights.
