

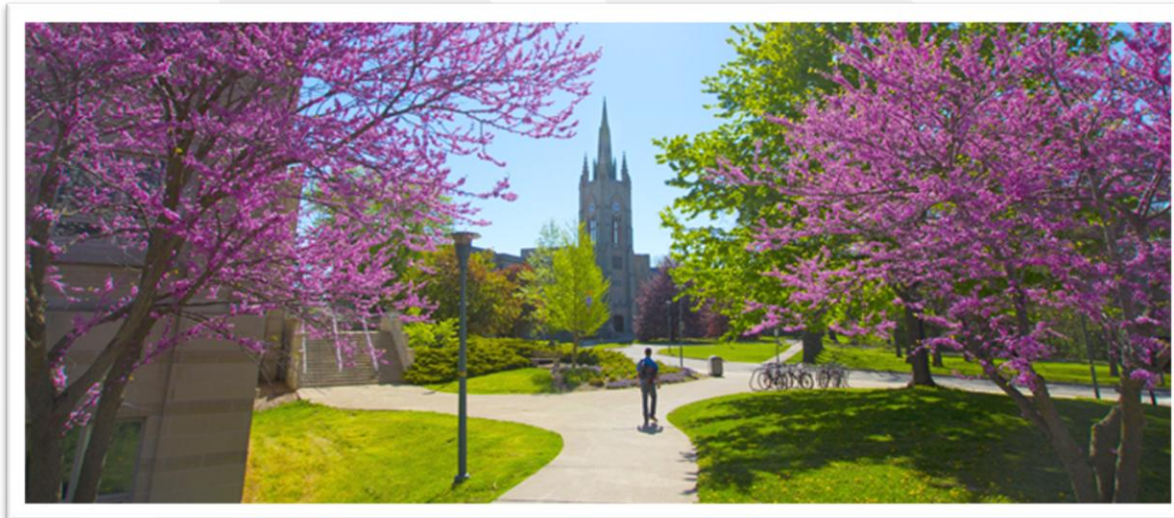


2) WELCOME TO WESTERN

 - Student health plan



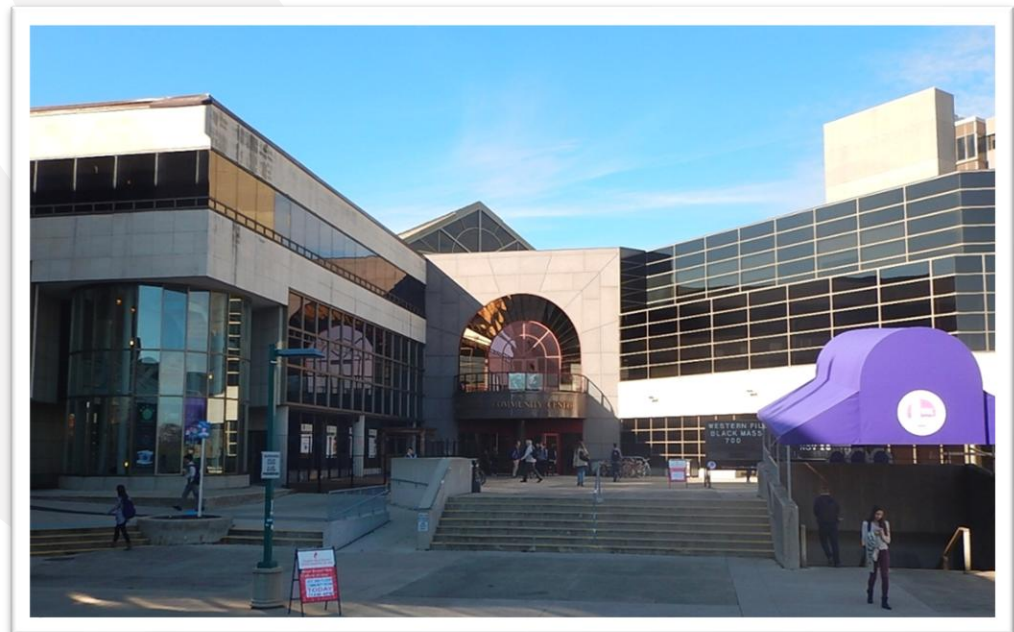
CENTRE FOR TEACHING AND LEARNING (CTL)

- They offer a lot of free programs and certificates which will improve your much-needed teaching skills.



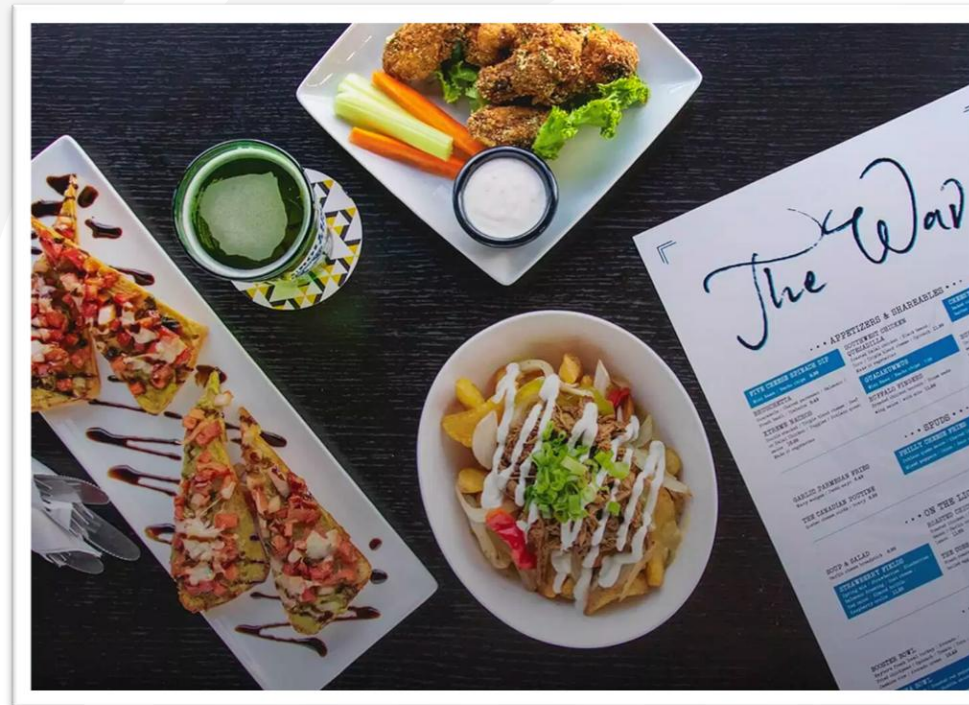
THE UCC
