Major: C, G, A, E, F Minor: A, E, D

Scales: Major, Harmonic and Melodic Minor Arpeggios: Major, Minor, Dom 7<sup>th</sup>, Dim 7<sup>th</sup>

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### HARP: M1920, M2925

Pieces: Two pieces of contrasting styles.
 Minimum grade level: Grade 8 RCM

2) Studies: One selection equivalent to Grade 8 RCM

3) **Technique**: Grade 8 RCM - follow written directions and tempi

Major: C, G, D, A, E, F, Bb, Eb Minor: A, E, B, F#, C#, D, G, C Melodic Minor: A, E, D, G, C

Scales: Major, Harmonic and Melodic

Rolled and Broken Four Note Chords: Major, Minor, Dom 7<sup>th</sup>, Dim 7<sup>th</sup>

Rolled and Broken Arpeggios: Major, Minor, Dom 7<sup>th</sup>, Dim 7<sup>th</sup>

4) **Orchestral Excerpts**: One excerpt of teacher's choice

4) **Sight-Reading**: Excerpt(s) provided by teacher

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# HARP: M2921, M2922

- Pieces: Three pieces of contrasting styles. Must include at least one original transcription or contemporary (post-1960) work.
   Minimum grade level: Grade 9 RCM
- 2) Studies: One selection equivalent to Grade 9 RCM
- 3) Orchestral Excerpts: Two excerpts of teacher's choice
- 4) **Sight-Reading**: Excerpt(s) provided by teacher

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### HARP: M3920, M3929, M4925

- Pieces: Two pieces of contrasting styles Minimum grade level: Grade 10 RCM
- 2) Studies: One selection equivalent to Grade 10 RCM
- 3) Orchestral Excerpts: One excerpt of teacher's choice
- 4) **Sight-Reading & Pedal Exercise**: Excerpt(s) provided by teacher

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HARP: M3924Y, M4924Y

Two or more contrasting works and studies and/or orchestral excerpts. Repertoire and level are teacher's choice

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#### HARP:

M3921 Jury scheduled in December. Prepare 10 minutes of music. M3922 Jury scheduled in April. Prepare 20 minutes of music.

The **3921** jury will consist of two parts:

- 1) **Studies**: One selection equivalent Grade 10 RCM
- 2) Orchestral Excerpts: Two excerpts of teacher's choice

The **3922** jury will consist of three parts:

- Pieces: Two pieces of contrasting styles Minimum grade level: Grade 10 RCM
- 2) **Studies**: One selection equivalent to Grade 10 RCM
- 3) Orchestral Excerpts: Two excerpts of teacher's choice

# M3930a/b/y RECITAL

A variety of styles should be presented. Must include at least one original transcription or contemporary (post-1960) work.

**Time**: 35-45 minutes of music (no intermission). See Handbook for more information.

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Repertoire and etudes in applied jury 4920 and 4929 (inclusive of orchestral excerpts) must amount to a total playing time not less than 30 minutes.

#### HARP: M4920, M4929

- Pieces: Two pieces of contrasting styles & one movement of a concerto Minimum grade level: Grade 10 RCM
- 2) Studies: One selection equivalent Grade 10 RCM
- 3) Orchestral Excerpts: Two excerpts of teacher's choice
- 4) Sight-Reading & Pedal Exercise: Excerpt(s) provided by teacher

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HARP: M4921, M4922, M4923

**Note**: The **4921-23** jury, scheduled at the end of <u>term I</u>, will consist of two parts:

1) **Studies**: One selection equivalent Grade 10 RCM

2) Orchestral Excerpts: Three excerpts of teacher's choice

# M4930a/b/y, M4931a/b/y, M4932a/b/y RECITAL

Must include at least one:

- 1) Baroque piece
- 2) Sonata
- 3) Virtuosic solo piece, concerto, OR chamber work (i.e., quintet, trio, or duo)
- 4) 20<sup>th</sup> or 21<sup>st</sup> century piece by a Canadian composer

Time: 45-55 minutes of music (10-minute intermission optional). See Handbook.

Selections may not overlap with repertoire from M3930a/b/y recital.
