## PROGRAMS OTHER THAN PERFORMANCE

<u>M1140 Course Requirements</u>: Students are expected to study at least 30 minutes of music during the academic year. This repertoire must be documented on the jury form.

M1140 Jury Requirements: 15 minutes of music from at least two different epochs at the Grade 6 level or higher.

M1925 Course and Jury Requirements: Same as Music 1140.

<u>M1920 Course Requirements</u>: Students are expected to study at least 45 minutes of music that represents at least five epochs. This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must be documented on the jury form.

<u>M1920 Jury Requirements</u>: 20 minutes of music. *This jury program must include a variety of musical and technical challenges.* 

M2925 Course and Jury Requirements: The same as Music 1920.

<u>M2920 Course Requirements</u>: Students are expected to study at least 45 minutes of music that represents at least five epochs. This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and must be documented on the jury form. There may be no duplications of repertoire from Music 1920.

<u>M2920 Jury Requirements</u>: 20 minutes of music. *This jury program must include a variety of musical and technical challenges.* 

M3925 Course and Jury Requirements: The same as Music 2920

<u>M3920, 3929 Course Requirements</u>: Students are expected to study at least 45 minutes of music that represents at least five epochs. This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must be documented on the jury form. There may be no duplications of repertoire from Music 1920 or 2920.

<u>M3920, 3929 Jury Requirements</u>: 20 minutes of music. *This jury program must include a variety of musical and technical challenges.* 

M4925 Course and Jury Requirements: The same as Music 3920.

<u>M3924Y Jury Requirements</u>: Two or more contrasting works and technical studies and/or orchestral excerpts to total the time of the jury which shall be 15 minutes. The teacher shall choose the repertoire and level.

<u>M4920, 4929 Course Requirements</u>: Students are expected to study at least 60 minutes of music that represents at least five epochs. This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must be documented on the jury form. There may be no duplications of repertoire from Music 1920, 2920, or 3920.

<u>M4920, 4929 Jury Requirements</u>: 30 minutes of music. *This jury program must include a variety of musical and technical challenges.* 

M4924Y Jury Requirements: Two or more contrasting works and technical studies and/or orchestral excerpts to total

### Performance

<u>M2921, M2922 Course Requirements</u>: During the academic year, students are expected to study at least 60 minutes of music representing at least five epochs. *This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must be documented on the jury form.* There may be no duplications of repertoire from Music 1920.

<u>M292</u>, <u>M2922</u> Jury Requirements: 30 minutes of music. *This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges*. There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 1920.

<u>M3921 Course Requirements</u>: During the academic year, students are expected to study at least 60 minutes of music representing at least five epochs. This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must be documented on the Recital 3926 form. There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 1920 or 2921.

<u>M3921 Jury Requirements</u>: Students will perform ten minutes of music that is not part of their recital program. *This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges*. This jury will be held in early December before the Christmas break. The mark for this exam will represent 20% of the final grade for Music 374. There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 1920 or 2921.

<u>M3922 Course Requirements</u>: During the academic year, students are expected to study at least 60 minutes of music representing at least five epochs. There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 2921.

<u>M3922 Jury Requirements</u>: 30 minutes of music. *This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges.* There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 2921.

<u>Music 3930b Recital</u>: Students are required to present a well-balanced program of 35-45 minutes in length. *This program must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must demonstrate a high level of artistic perception and technical competence*. There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 1920 or 2921.

<u>M4921, M4922</u>, <u>M4923 Course Requirements</u>: During the academic year, students are expected to study at least 60 minutes of music representing at least five epochs. This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must be documented on the Recital 4926 form. There may be no duplication of repertoire from previous years.

<u>M4921, M4922</u>, <u>M4923 Jury Requirements</u>: Students will perform ten minutes of music that is not part of their recital program. *This repertoire must include a variety of musical and technical challenges*. The jury will be held in early December before the Christmas break. The mark for this exam will represent 20% of the final grade for M4921. There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 1920, 2921 or 3921.

<u>Music 4930b Recital</u>: Students are required to present a well-balanced program of 45-55 minutes in length. *This program must include a variety of musical and technical challenges and it must demonstrate a high level of artistic perception and technical competence*. There may be no duplication of repertoire from Music 1920, 2921 or 3921.
