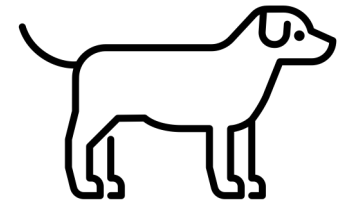


The One Health Approach and Cannabidiol (CBD)

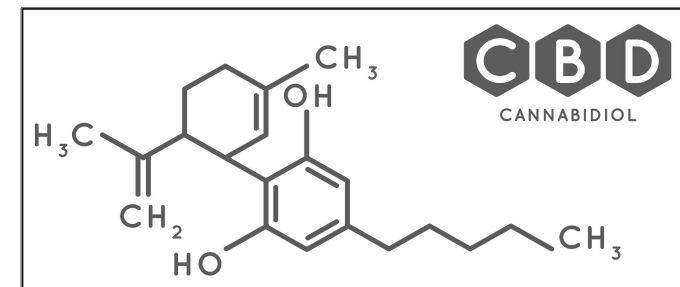
- CBD is a phytocannabinoid and the second most prevalent component of cannabis.
