

Selecting a Student Parking Permit

A permit provides access to a zone and does not guarantee a parking space in a specific parking lot unless you have a reserved parking permit.

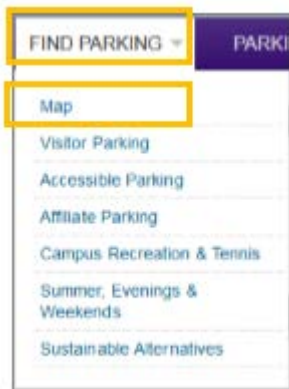
Students are eligible for the Green Zone Non-Reserved permits, Evening/Weekend Permits, Motorcycle Permits, as well as Reserved Permits (when available).

For anything other than a student non-reserved permit, please email: wparking@uwo.ca for availability.

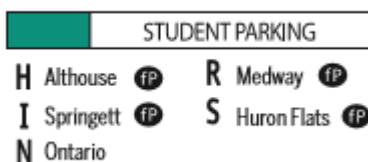
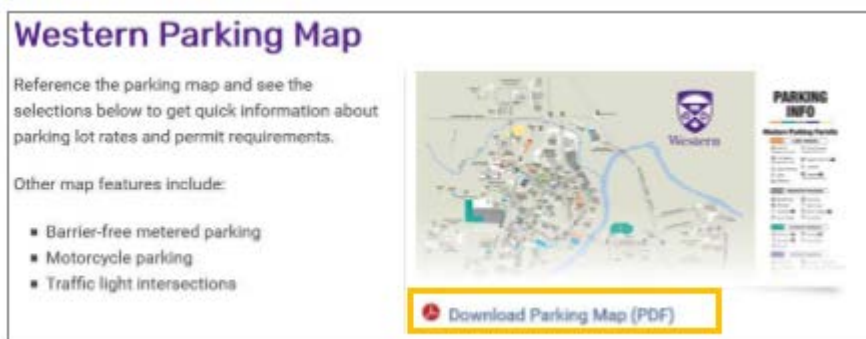
TIP: Students who work on campus, regardless of their employment role, are considered 'Student' for the purpose of purchasing a permit and will have a Green Non-Reserved Permit.

Follow the steps below to learn where the student parking lots are located.

- 1) Go to the website <http://www.uwo.ca/parking>
- 2) Hover over 'Find Parking' from the menu at the top, and a) Click on 'Map' from the drop-down menu.



- b) Click 'Download Parking Map (PDF)' to review the Student Parking Zones available on campus.
