

Honours Specialization in Philosophy

Admission requirements: Completion of first year requirements (**5.0 first-year credits**) with no failures. Student must have an average of at least 70% in 3.0 principal courses with no mark below 60%. 1.0 course from Philosophy 1020, Philosophy 1022E, Philosophy 1100E, Philosophy 1200 is recommended.

Module: 9.0 courses

Note: At least 4.0 of the 9.0 must be at the 3000 level or higher.

4.0 additional courses in Philosophy at the 2000 level or higher.			

Progression requirements for honours modules: minimum cumulative average of 70% (applies to all years) no grade less than 60% on required module courses, no fails in ANY course, fail being under 50%

Additional graduation requirements:

- 6.0 electives
- 20.0 total credits to graduate
- 2.0 essay credits (F/G/E) – maximum of 1.0 essay credits can be at the 1000 level
- 1.0 Category A (Social Science) credits & 1.0 Category C (Science) credits
- **Note:** make sure you have a minimum of 5.0 1000 level courses, maximum 7.0 allowed. Students must have a minimum of 13.0 senior credits to graduate
